

MYTH:

Outside special interest groups are stealing your vote.

FACT:

In order to legally fund the recall effort, Exeter citizens have formed a political action committee (PAC) in compliance with Rhode Island's campaign finance laws. The law requires the appointment of a Treasurer and Deputy Treasurer, the only person(s) associated with the PAC authorized to accept or expend funds. Both positions are held by Exeter residents. The other committee members are strictly volunteers acting in an advisory capacity and have no legal authority over the PAC or its funds.

In the past 2 years, the 4 councilors attempted to deny Exeter citizens' authority (your rights) and to transfer them to the state while ignoring the will of people. This required that we, the concerned citizens of Exeter, take action to initiate this recall. This is not just a case of disagreeing with the opinion of the councilors, because reasonable people can disagree. However, the egregious abuses of power were numerous and necessitated this recall even prior to the upcoming election of 2014. This is not a case of simple political differences, but rather a serious violation of public trust leaving us with no option except to demand accountability for honest and transparent government.
