It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 11-47-48.1 of the General Laws in Chapter 11-47 entitled 2 "Weapons" is hereby amended to read as follows:

11-47-48.1. Report of lost or stolen weapons.

4 Every person who owns a firearm shall report the loss or theft of their firearm to the local 5 law enforcement agency municipal police department in the town where the firearm was last located or, if there is no such police department, to the Rhode Island state police, within twenty-6 7 four (24) hours of the discovery of the loss or theft. Whoever knowingly violates this section shall 8 be punished by a fine of not less than fifty dollars (\$50.00) nor more than one hundred dollars 9 (\$100) nor more than five hundred dollars (\$500), a term of imprisonment of not more than one 10 year, or both, and upon a second or subsequent conviction by a fine of not less than two hundred fifty dollars (\$250) and not more than one thousand dollars (\$1,000), a term of imprisonment of 12 not more than three (3) years, or both.

(b) Every person who knowingly makes a false report of a lost or stolen firearm shall be punished by a fine of not less than one hundred dollars (\$100) and up to five hundred dollars (\$500), a term of imprisonment of not more than one year, or both, and upon a second or subsequent conviction by a fine of not less than two hundred fifty dollars (\$250) and not more than one thousand dollars (\$1,000), a term of imprisonment of not more than three (3) years, or
